Subject: Clifton Gateway Public Realm Scheme

Dear Sir or Madam,

AECOM, acting on behalf of the Department for Communities (DfC), are writing to inform you of a new public realm environmental improvement scheme known as the Clifton Gateway Project which has been proposed for lands following the route of Donegall Street beginning at York Street along Clifton Street and the Crumlin Road to its junction with Agnes Street, including Donegall Lane, Union Street (part), North Queens Street (part), Henry Place and Carlisle Circus.

Why have you been informed?

What is the proposed scheme?

Scheme combines landscape and civil engineering improvements to include: repaving footways, road carriageway surfacing, drainage works, refurbishment and replacement of boundary railings, installation of street furniture, replacement street lighting and street tree planting.
