  - Would the net permanent total stadium capacity have to be reduced below 34,188 to facilitate the substitution of permanent seating accommodation for a standing terrace?
  - What would be the permanent reduction in net spectator capacity?
- Alternatively, if the permanent seating capacity is to remain at the approved 26,013, has UEFA granted an exemption for the installation of temporary seating at a redeveloped Casement Park for the purpose of hosting the Euro 2028 Finals tournament?
- If such an exemption has been granted, what number of temporary seats would need to be installed?
- Has UEFA granted an exemption to permit the use of standing spectator capacity at Casement Park for the Euro 2028 Finals, i.e., the admission of non-seated spectators?
